

SCHOOL ACHIEVEMENT AWARD

This award is given by the Department for Education and Skills in recognition of the significant progress the school has made.



ARTSMARK SILVER

The school received this award this year in recognition of the high standard of arts within the school and the links between the arts and the other areas of the curriculum. Our school was one of only 7 in Somerset to receive this award, which is a nationally recognised award from the Arts Council. This award was reaffirmed in June 2006.



SCHOOLS EXTRA AWARD

ACTIVEMARK GOLD

The school received this award this year in recognition of the high standard of physical education and sport within the school. Our school was one of only 3 in Somerset to receive this award, which is a nationally recognised award from the Sport England.



FA CHARTER MARK SCHOOL

The school received this award for the high standard teaching of football skills within the PE curriculum and for the provision made for teaching football skills as an out-of-school-hours activity.

ENVIRONMENTAL YOUTH AWARD

This award was presented to the school by the Royal Bath & West Society in recognition of the work carried out by the school in furthering environmental education with children and in particular the practical involvement of children in developing their own natural environment. The school received both the awards for Somerset and the Regional award.

PARTNERSHIP SCHOOL WITH EXETER UNIVERSITY

This award is for the work carried out by the school in the partnership with the University of Exeter to support initial teacher training.



OFSTED OUTSTANDING SCHOOLS

This award has been given to schools by Ofsted, who are the schools' inspectorate in recognition of outstanding achievement.
