

## SECTION 3

### THE CURRICULUM

Throughout the Primary years the children are taught within the framework of the National Curriculum as prescribed by the Government to ensure all children have equal access to a broad and balanced curriculum.

For much of the time children study the core subjects of English and Mathematics.

They will also cover:

- Science
- Information Technology
- History
- Geography
- Music
- Design and Technology
- Art and Design
- Physical Education
- Religious Education
- Personal and Social Education
- A Modern Foreign Language

Some subjects are taught separately. Sometimes several different subjects are involved in a study which lasts for half a term or longer.

Each teacher plans work carefully to ensure that learning experiences are developmental and appropriate to the needs of each child. We recognise that children are individuals and that development will occur at different rates and in different ways.

Activities are planned to ensure that the children learn facts, develop understanding and improve their skills in a stimulating and relevant way.

The School has developed a Curriculum Framework called the Inspirational Curriculum to ensure that the National Curriculum is covered. Children aged four follow the Foundation Stage curriculum to prepare them for the National Curriculum. Children aged five to seven are following the programme of study for Key Stage One. Children aged eight to eleven follow the programme of study for Key Stage Two.
