We try to make each day's collective worship slightly different and children can expect to sing, listen to stories, listen to musicians, watch short plays, and make points themselves. All teachers as well as our local Rector take our Acts of Worship.

Each Friday we hold a Celebration Assembly where we look at good work and praise the efforts of the children.
