MEDICAL MATTERS

ASTHMA

Our policy is that children should have unrestricted access to their own inhalers. We advise that children carry small inhalers around with them at all times either in a 'bum bag' or in their pocket. Larger inhalers need to be kept to hand in class. All our teaching staff have received some training from health professionals.

MEDICATION

If a doctor prescribes medicines for your child, they may, at the discretion of the Head Teacher, be administered at school. These should always be clearly labelled with the child's name and dosage, and handed directly to the school office. A form will need to be signed by the parent.

SICKNESS

If your child is off school due to sickness, please notify the school office as soon as possible. A written note should be forwarded to the Head Teacher with the details of the sickness.

If there is any other information that we should know about in respect of your child's health, i.e. allergies, please advise the school office and your child's teacher.
