

## **SCHOOL MEALS**

Hot meals are no longer provided within the Somerset L A. area, but the school has set up a hot meals service for 3 days per week. Parents should send their children to school with a packed lunch and a drink in a plastic container on all days they are not having a hot meal. Children may go home at lunchtime. Children in Key Stage 2 should bring a healthy snack such as fruit or vegetables to be eaten during the first break, this is provided free of charge to children in Key Stage 1. Milk is available free to children under 5 and at a subsidised price for those over 5. Children are asked to bring a sealable water bottle to school, which they can refill, from our chilled and filtered water dispenser in the main building. They are encouraged to drink water regularly. Families receiving Income Support or Job Seekers Allowance (Income Based) are entitled to free school meals. Full details are available from the school office.

## **LOST PROPERTY**

Any lost property is kept in the School Office. Named items are returned to the children. Anything, which has not been named, will be placed in lost property. We regularly empty this in an attempt to return clothing to the right owner. Please do not allow your child to bring valuables to school.

## **MONEY**

Occasionally it is necessary for large amounts of money to be sent to school e.g. for school trips. Please ensure that all money is securely sealed in an envelope which is clearly marked with the child's name and that it is handed to your child's class learning support assistant immediately.

## **PHOTOGRAPHS**

It is the school's policy to seek parental consent annually for photographic and video use of images. Children's photos may be used on the school website, but individual children will not be identified.
