

SPECIAL EDUCATIONAL NEEDS

Many children occasionally need extra help with some aspect of learning. At these times extra support will be offered by our School Special Needs Education Coordinator (SENCO), class teachers, and Learning Support Assistants (LSAs). Children who need special help receive extra support individually or in small groups with work specifically designed for their particular needs. For the majority of time this support is offered within the classroom but for some activities children may be taught in another working space.

Sometimes the school will seek additional help and advice in the form of Speech and Language Therapists, Advisory or Support Teachers, or Educational Psychologists.

Should you have any concerns about the progress your child is making then the class teacher will always be happy to discuss these with you.
