

INFORMATION COMMUNICATION TECHNOLOGY

It is important that from the beginning of their school life children are given the opportunities to develop their skills and understanding of ICT. In a world, which relies increasingly on computers children are encouraged to become confident in data handling, work processing and controlling systems. We have an ICT suite in the main building, which is used by all pupils, and this is linked to satellite suites in our other classrooms. All our classes have interactive whiteboards. We have a policy of updating our hardware as often as financially possible and as part of the National Grid for Learning we are linked to the Internet and Somerset Education Services own Intranet.

GEOGRAPHY

Our children investigate the world in which they live. They use the skills of a Geographer to explore their immediate environment and the wider world. We aim to enable children to understand the physical and human features of the subject.

HISTORY

When learning about the past and how the world has been shaped we teach children to think as Historians and to use the skills of enquiry to help them understand events and lifestyles.
