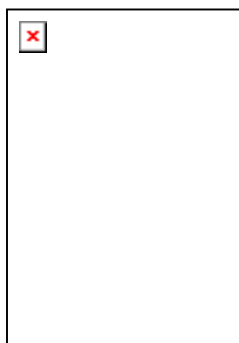

Trainee Teacher

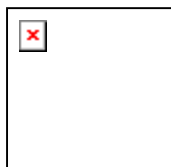
Welcome to Josie Vinyard who is a trainee teacher from Exeter University. She is working alongside Mrs Alexander during this term.
