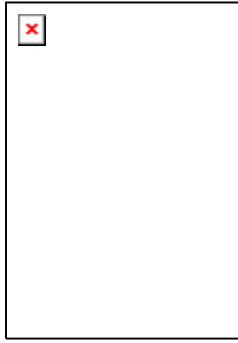

### General Consent

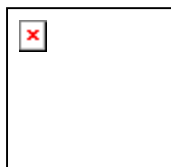
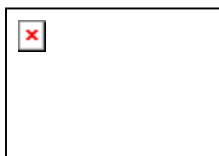
Thank you for returning these forms – there are a few outstanding in Water and Air classes. I would be grateful if you would return these before half term
