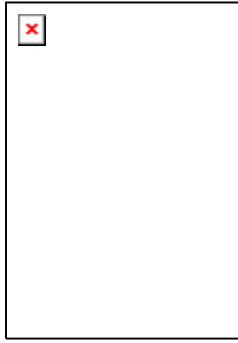

Musical Afternoon

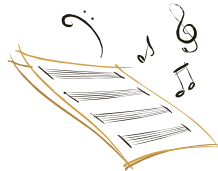
This is being held in St.

At the end of the afternoon the children should be collected from the church at 3.30pm. There will be the Fun Activity Club as usual after school and these children will be walked back to school.

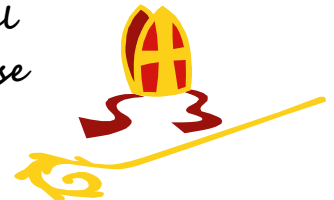

This year we also have a craft tent for children.

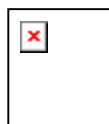
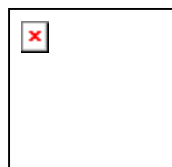
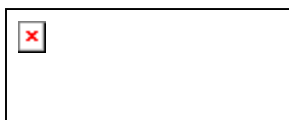


Play to Learn
