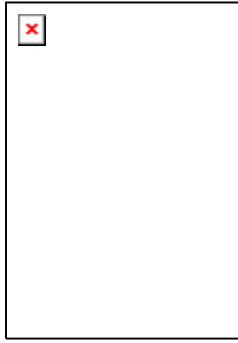

John's Church on

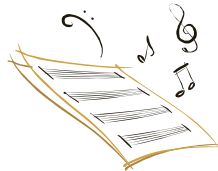
Thursday 24th June.

Year 6 pupils (who do not have an induction day).

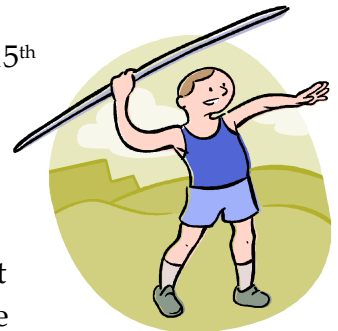
Non-uniform Friday

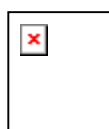
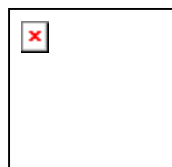
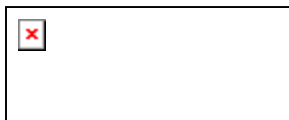
Sports Day

These are being taken in school on 30th June in the afternoon and then will be available on the playground for parents to order.



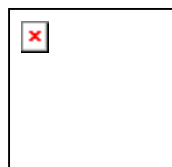
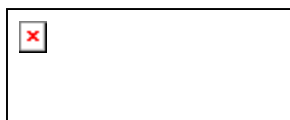
International School Award
