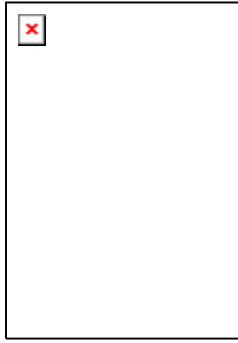

### **Top Link Athletics and Rounders**

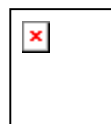
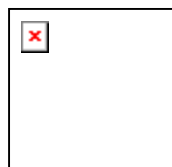
