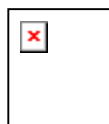
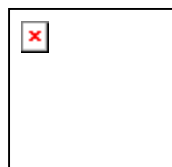
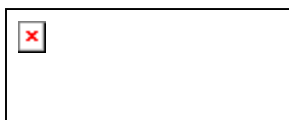


### **Consent Form for the Recording of Images**

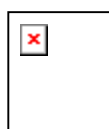
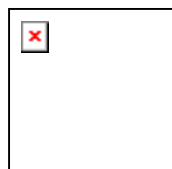
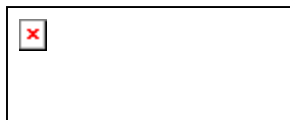
