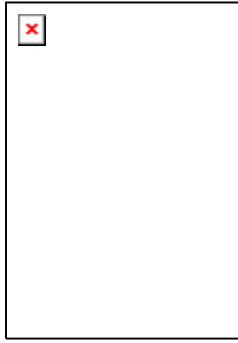

teacher working in our school who is a native French or Spanish speaker. I will let you know if our bid for grant funding is successful.



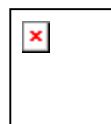
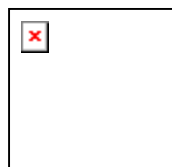
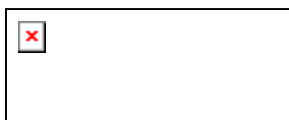
New Grounds Development
