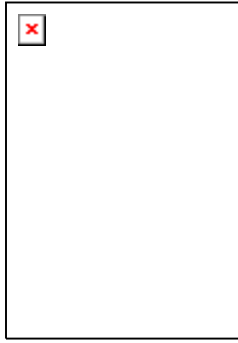

I have met recently with a catering company who are delivering a hot meals service to a number of schools in Somerset.

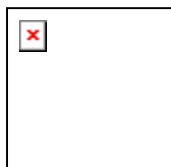
