We have some fluorescent jackets in school that we would be happy to loan to parents whose children walk or cycle to school. Please talk to Mrs Chubb.

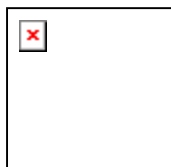
Sainsbury's Vouchers
