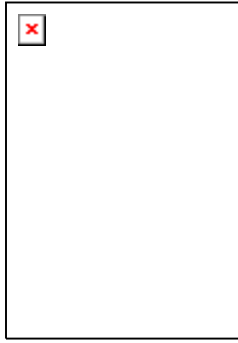

Grounds Day 2007

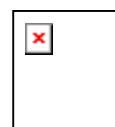
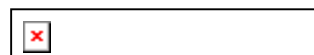
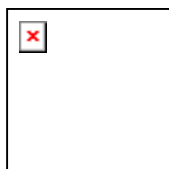

Musical Afternoon

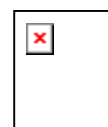
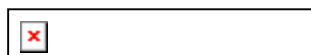
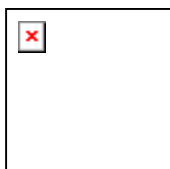
